COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOLS FOR 2020 MARCHING CONTESTS

1. Masks that cover the mouth and nose **WILL BE REQUIRED OF EVERYONE AT ALL TIMES** (except for students while performing).
2. All spectators, contest workers, judges, etc. will be required to complete a verbal health check (have you experienced symptoms such as cough, chill, headache, sore throat, etc.) and have their temperature taken before entering the stadium (following Calallen ISD COVID-19 Policy).
3. There will be **NO** formal result ceremonies or announcements.
4. Directors (or their designees) will receive all their critique sheets, judge comments, and other contest materials, at a location still to be determined, while their buses are being loaded. They can then communicate results to students, parents, administrators, and other supporters via social media or appropriate method for their program.
5. Contest will run on a 20-minute schedule.
6. Warm-up will be 20 minutes, on a covered practice field, located at the scoreboard end of the stadium.
7. When bands complete their performances, they will be led to their buses to load and depart the school grounds.
8. Visitor side bleachers will remain vacant.
9. Home side bleachers will be "roped off" into 6 to 8 sections, with each section assigned to a specific school.
10. Tickets are **LIMITED** and will only be available for pre-sale at the participating schools.
11. Tickets purchased at the school will be redeemed at the Stadium for **color coded** wristbands.
12. Schools performing in each "block" of performance (see contest schedule) will have different colored wristbands assigned to their spectators.
13. Wristbands will allow admission to the Stadium and will be valid **ONLY** during the "block" while that spectator's band is performing.
14. Spectators are restricted to the designated "roped off" section assigned to their school.
15. Monitors at the Stadium will assist spectators in finding their assigned bleacher section (based on wristband color).
16. Spectators should sit in their assigned sections, grouped with other household members, and socially distanced from other groups of household members within the assigned school section.
17. There will be **NO** ticket sales at the stadium, and **NO** In/Out (re-admission) privileges at the gate. (If a spectator leaves the Stadium, he/she will **NOT** be allowed back in.)
18. During the breaks between blocks of performances, the stadium bleachers will be emptied and deep-cleaned before the next group of spectators are admitted for the next block of bands to perform.

ON CALLEN ISD CLEAR BAG REQUIREMENTS

Applies to the following facilities at Calallen High School:

Stadium, Baseball Field, Softball Field, Gymnasium, and Auditorium

ACCEPTABLE:



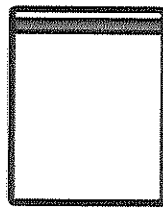
STADIUM SEATS

- without zippers/pockets



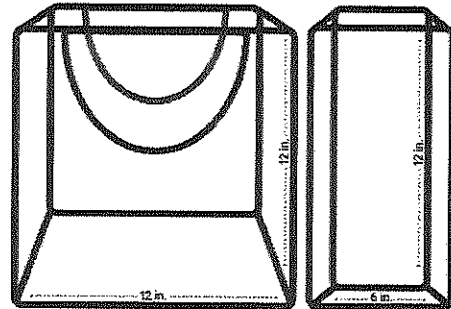
SMALL PURSE/CLUTCH

- cannot exceed 5.5 in. x 8.5 in.
- does not have to be clear
- with or without a strap



STORAGE BAG

- one-gallon, clear resealable plastic bag



CLEAR BAG

- cannot exceed 12 in. x 6 in. x 12 in.
- printed or patterned bags are not permissible
- one logo (not obstructing contents) is acceptable

PROHIBITED:

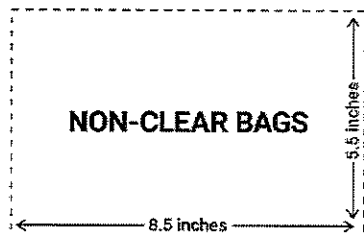
- Backpacks
- Duffel bags or large totes
- Purses larger than 5.5" x 8.5"
- Cases (camera, binocular, etc.)
- Mesh or straw bags
- Fanny packs
- Printed pattern or tinted plastic
- Folding chair bags
- Stadium seats with zippers or pockets
- Reusable grocery totes

EXCEPTIONS:

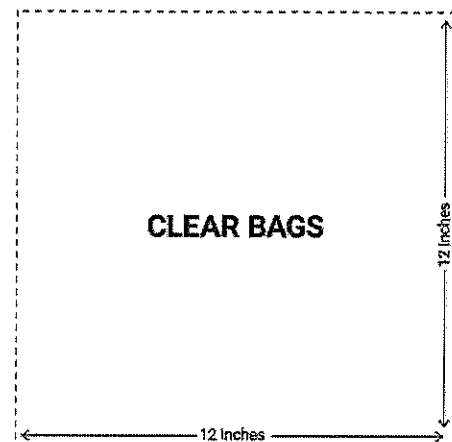
- Bags for medically necessary items
- News media equipment (for credentialed media)
- Official team and other field photographers
- Diaper bags (child must be present)

NOTE:

All bags are subject to inspection prior to entry regardless of size or type.
